Instructional Lead Fellowship

The Instructional Lead Fellowship is a 3-day program for Masterclass alumni and school leaders to build their capacity to embed and sustain high-impact instruction in their school. Working from a robust research base, the program enhances skills in designing impactful professional learning for staff, building an effective coaching framework and strengthening guaranteed and viable curriculum to enhance student learning.

The Experience

Instructional Lead Fellowship participants will:

- » Apply evidence in leading effective professional learning in schools;
- » Build their instructional coaching capacity, including through video moderation and coaching conversations;
- » Have access to resources for use in coaching and professional learning at school;
- » Identify elements of best practice from high-performing schools;
- » Review curriculum in your schools and implement strategies to embed low-variance curriculum;
- » Use a diagnostic tool to audit instructional resources in your context;
- » Develop and implement a targeted action plan to drive success at your school.

The Fellowship cost includes access to Teach Well's Learning Management System, including a comprehensive video library, extensive resources and curriculum materials.
